Miss Chaitali

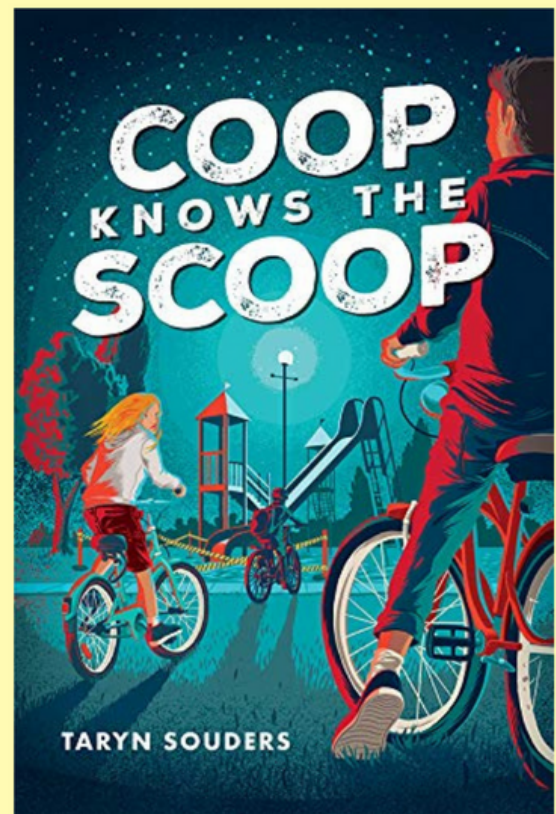

EARLY READING & WRITING
